

HOW TO TRACK A SHIPMENT WITH MULTIPLE CARTONS

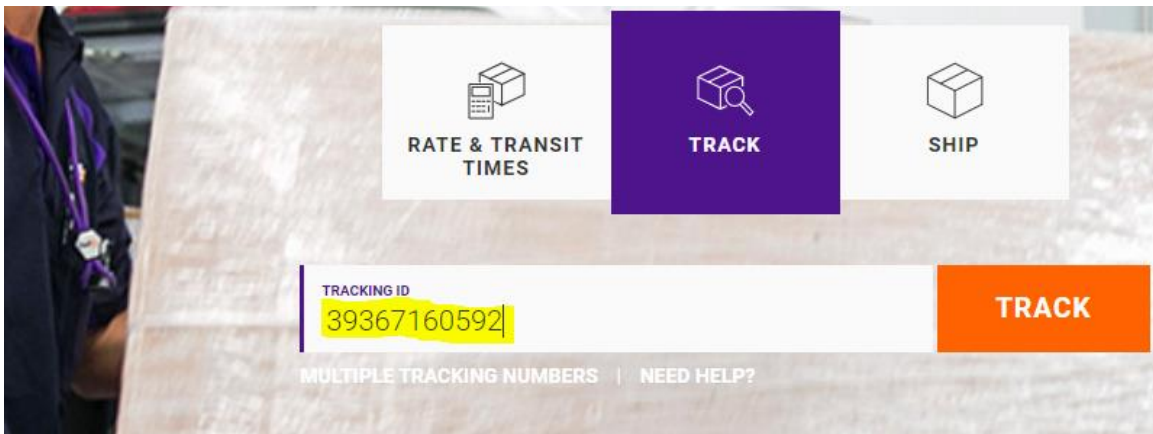
Each carton has its own tracking number and can be delivered at separate times by FEDEX – even across multiple days. It is very common for a package to be delivered 1-2 days after other packages within the same shipment.

1. Visit www.fedex.com
2. Find your tracking number on your confirmation email. This tracking number is simply the “master” number for the shipment. When you look at FEDEX tracking you will see that there is actually 1 tracking number per carton sent.

3. Enter your tracking number from your confirmation email – this will be your master tracking number



4. You can see there are multiple tracking numbers – 1 for each carton & the status of each package. Please note packages may separate in transit causing your packages to arrive on different days.
